The Cincinnati Gateway is a major interchange point to the South with connections to the CSX Corporation (L&N, Seaboard, Chessie, B&O) and the NS (Norfolk and Western, Southern). Grand Trunk Western has access to these carriers via trackage rights over Conrail. Aside from being a major rail transportation hub, it is also a major hub for motor, barge and air transportation.

Cincinnati is also a major industrial center with many international and national corporations headquartered here. It is known as the "Machine Tool Capital", "Soap Capital" among many nomenclatures.

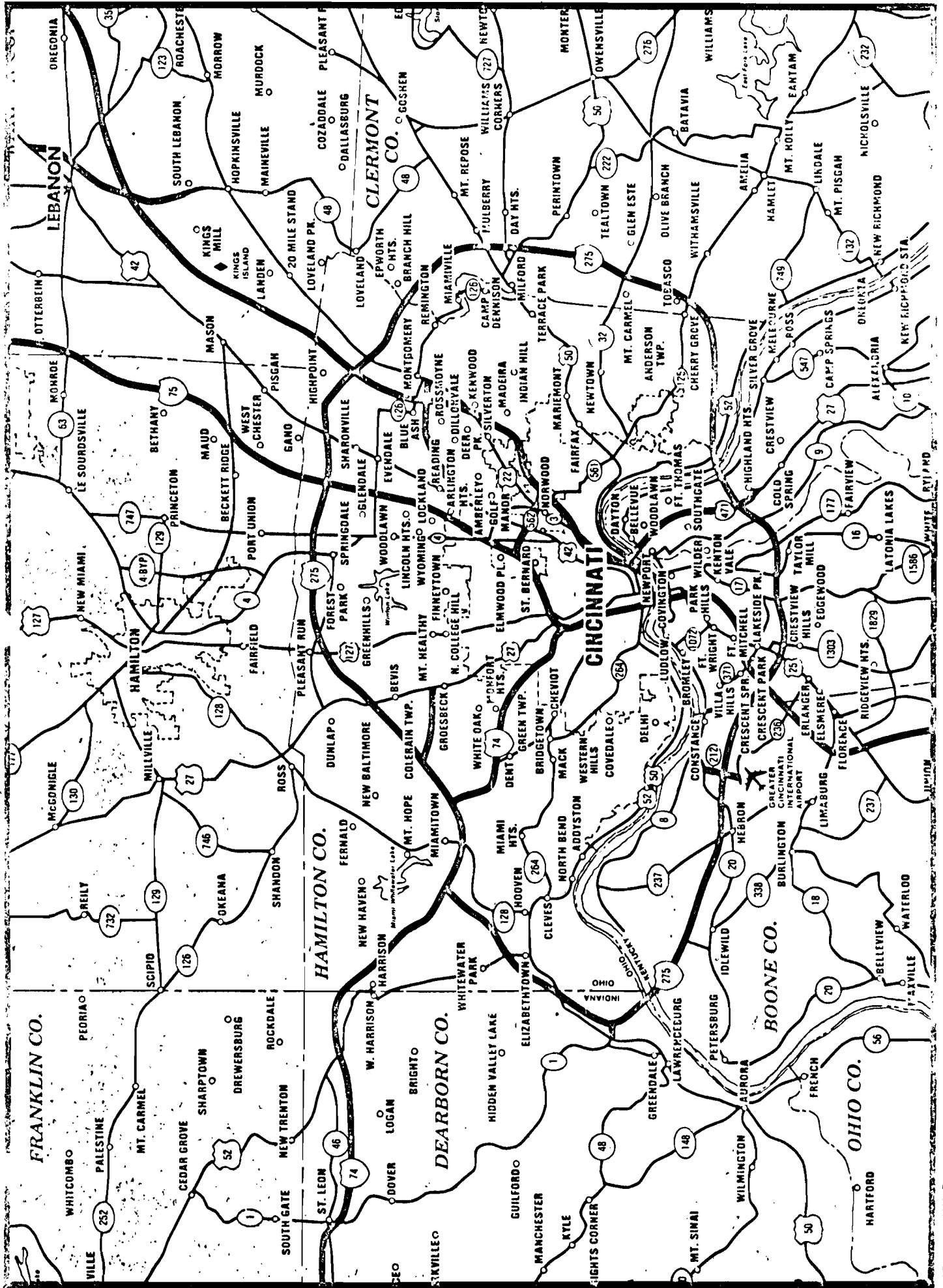
All told, Conrail services two hundred and forty five (245) industries, encompassing the Cincinnati District (Middletown, Cincinnati and Lawrenceburg).

Currently there are no Conrail trailvan trains operating in or out of the Cincinnati Terminal. Penn Truck Line maintains operations off the Strip at Sharon Yard for storage and repair of trailers, and to provide trailers to industries as needed. Loaded trailers are transported by highway to Twentieth Street, Columbus, to make scheduled van trains. Occasionally, TOFC's are placed on the Strip when PTL needs additional system trailers.

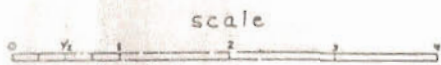
There is no flexi-flo facility in the Cincinnati Terminal, but negotiations are being conducted with a private carrier (Maxwell Inc.) to start a bulk facility at Vaughan Yard.

Also, presently, there is no multi-level loading or unloading in the Cincinnati Terminal. Facilities exist (sharon Strip) should volume or service dictate.

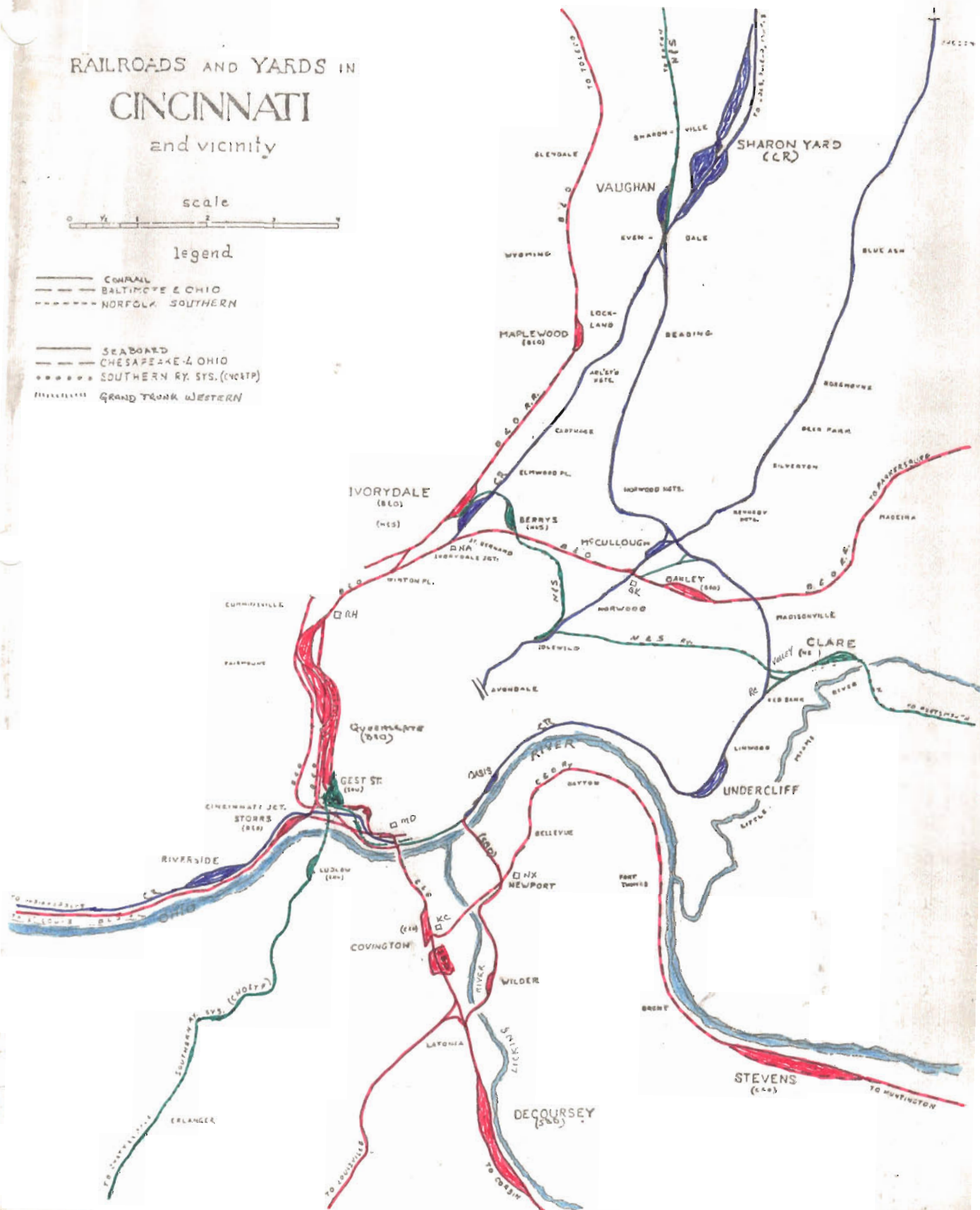
Provided all problems can be worked out with the City of Cincinnati Council, Queen City Terminals will be receiving Benzene tank traffic from Lima, Ohio at Cincinnati (Undercliff area) routed Chessie - Dayton - CR. The cars will be handled in unit tank trains, sixty (60) cars in increments of five (5) strings, twelve (12) cars to a string, which are inseparable unless absolutely necessary and under strict guidelines. The service was to commence in early August 1984, but is still in limbo pending Council's final approval.
